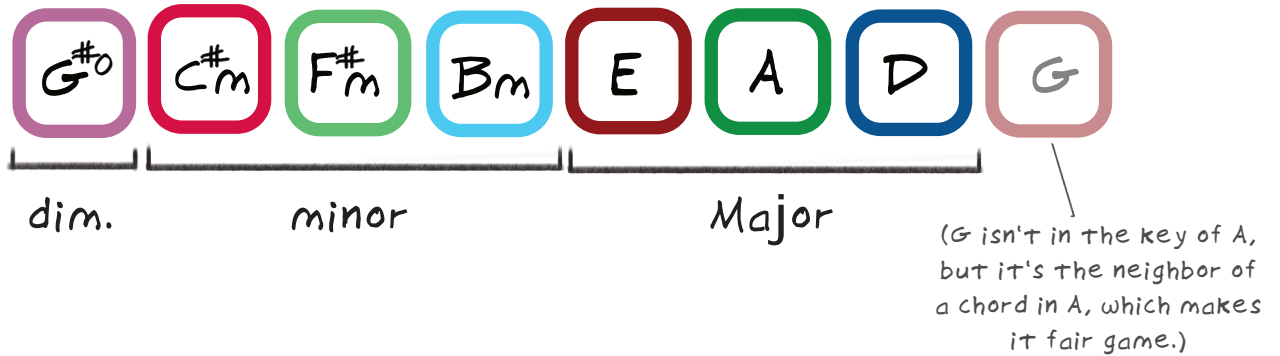


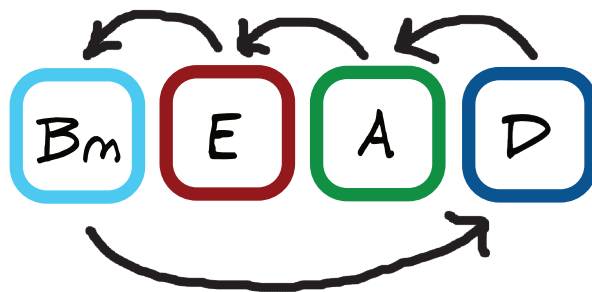
# BEAD Guides Chord Flow

"Just Like Heaven" Was The Cure's breakthrough single in America. While other songs of theirs ended up charting higher, this seems to be the one everyone knows. The song opens with a four chord loop and basically sticks to that throughout, with a bouncy groove that seems to embody the excitement of feeling really in love. The four chords it loops on come directly from BEAD Guides Chord Flow in the Key of A.



It moves left from the key center of A to E, then on to Bm, then loops over to the right neighbor of A, D, before returning back home.



It's bridge jumps up to the A chord's relative minor, F#m, and vamps between F#m and it's fret neighbor G. It does this three times before moving left in BEAD GCF to G's neighbor D, and then returning back home to A.
