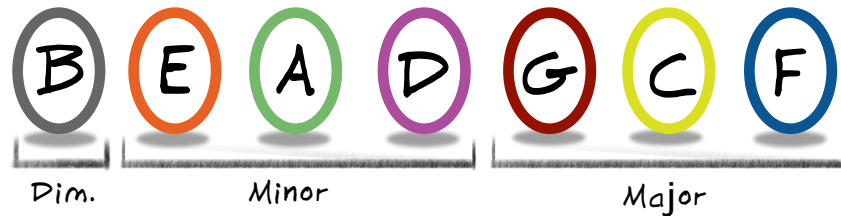


BEAD Guides Chord Flow

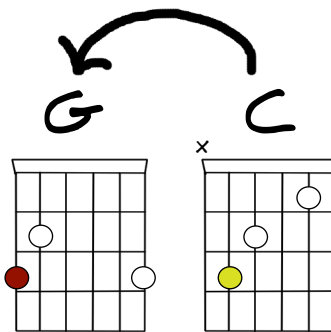

"Where Did Our Love Go," was the first of five consecutive hits performed by The Supremes. The chords are right in the wheel house of BEAD Guides Chord Flow. It simply uses four chords in a row in the key of C: Dm, G, C, and F

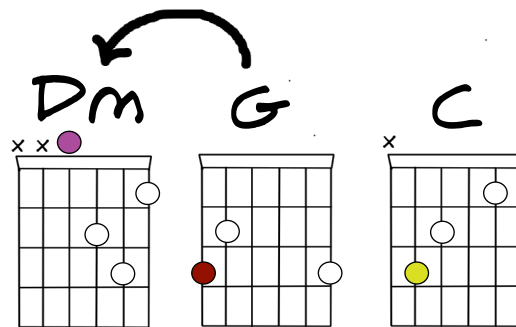
Here's the key of C sorted by BEAD Guides Chord Flow



The song starts out on the C chord, which in the key of C feels stable and steady, like home. From C it hops to the G chord on the word "leave" on the lyric "baby don't leave me"



The Dm is introduced on the word "leave" in the pleading repetition, "Please, don't leave me."



Then we return to the G chord and briefly visit F, and returns home to C. This pattern loop repeats itself throughout the song.
